Dear Student Government Applicant:

In order to be eligible to run for any position on Burnaby North's Student Government for next year, the following must be completed or obtained:

- **15** signatures from **students in your grade** who support/nominate you as a candidate of the Student Government (see reverse)
- Complete the attached **Student Government Application Form**
- **2** completed **teacher referral** forms from teachers who support you as a candidate for the position you are running for on Student Government
- Your **parent/guardian's signature** at the end of this form.
- Demonstrated exemplary behaviour and attendance
- Good academic standing

Student Government Information and Responsibilities:

- Requires a significant time commitment (before, during, and after school)
- Requires good time management ability – to maintain good standing in other subjects
- Requires enrolment in the Student Government course for next year.
- Involved planning and organizing many large school events and activities including theme days, lunchtime activities etc.

Note: No student will be allowed to campaign for Student Government positions unless they have filled out an application form, gone through the selection process, and been approved.

Completed application forms (with referrals) are due on Wednesday, March 10th, 2021 by 3:00 pm in room 114 (Office) or emailed to burnabynorthvikings@gmail.com by the deadline.

Applications will be reviewed by the Student Government Advisors and School Administrators to determine your eligibility to run in the election.

A list of chosen candidates will be posted outside of room 116 by Friday, March 12th by 2:45pm.
